Knowledge-base (KB) is a tool to unify the management of information such as titles in a package, URLs, or accessible volumes and numbers that are frequently updated.

To build a Japanese knowledge-base

ERDB-JP is a knowledge-base for Japanese e-resources, whose data are maintained by its partners.

To disseminate Japanese e-resources to the world

By providing the data in ERDB-JP to global knowledge-bases, it helps to disseminate Japanese digital publications such as universities' bulletins to the world.






Be connected, be available

By registering individual data excluded from a package, it can increase the number of e-resources that 'are available'.
